

RESOLUTION 2021-007

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEWBURG BOROUGH COUNCIL,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA CONFIRMING THE
ADOPTION OF A BALLOT QUESTION FOR THE 2021 MUNICIPAL
PRIMARY ELECTION.**

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania General Assembly adopted a "Local Option" Liquor Code Bill, Act 48 of July 2, 2019, P.L. 341 to allow for public approval of various liquor licenses with the intent to promote economic development of Pennsylvania municipalities, while helping to promote and strengthen the malt and brewed beverage and winery industries within the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Newburg Borough Council, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania to set forth on the ballot of the 2021 Municipal Primary Election for the Borough of Newburg a local option question for the consideration of Newburg Borough voters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby adopted by the Newburg Borough Council as follows:

1. A petition shall be circulated within the Borough of Newburg requiring the signature of at a minimum 43 electors, who shall agree to have the following Local Option question placed on the ballot of the 2021 Municipal Primary Election:

Do you favor the granting of liquor licenses for the sale of liquor, wine and malt and brewed beverages in Newburg Borough, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania?

2. The Newburg Borough Solicitor shall hereby be authorized to present to the Cumberland County Bureau of Elections the signed petition along with this Resolution with a request that the Local Option question be placed on the official election ballot for the Borough of Newburg, in the 2021 Municipal Primary Election.
