RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 13

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWBURG APPOINTING AMBER METCALF AS A MEMBER OF BOROUGH COUNCIL TO FILL THE VACANCY IN OFFICE CREATED BY THE RESIGNATION OF MELISSA NEGLEY.

WHEREAS, Ms. Negley was elected as Council Member of the Borough in November 2017 for a four year term which would end on the first Monday in January 2022; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Negley has resigned and the resignation has created a vacancy on Borough Council which Borough Council has the authority to fill in accordance with Section 901 of the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council has deemed it in the best interest of the Borough to appoint Amber Metcalf as a member of Borough Council until the first Monday in January 2020 when the individual elected to Borough Council in the November 2019 election takes office; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Metcalf is a registered elector of the Borough and has been a continuous resident of the Borough for over one year; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council deems Ms. Metcalf to be qualified to serve as a member of Borough Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council for the Borough of Newburg as follows:

1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference hereto.
2. Amber Metcalf is hereby appointed to serve on Borough Council until the first Monday in January 2020 when the individual elected to Borough Council in the November 2019 election takes office.
3. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective immediately.




