RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 03**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWBURG,
CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO APPOINT A MEMBER TO THE
ZONING HEARING BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Newburg (the "Borough") has enacted a Zoning Ordinance and established a Zoning Hearing Board in accordance with the requirements of the Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. §10101 *et seq.* ("MPC"); and

WHEREAS, Section 903 of the MPC provides that members of the Zoning Hearing Board are to be appointed by resolution; and

WHEREAS, Zoning Hearing Board member Bill Haines's term expired on January 1, 2018 and did not desire to accept a new appointment for a three (3) year term; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to appoint a replacement member to the Zoning Hearing Board to fill the vacancy created by the expiration of Haines's term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Newburg, County of Cumberland and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that:

Section 1. Pursuant to § 903(a) of the MPC, 53 P.S. § 10903(a), the Borough Council of the Borough of Newburg hereby appoints Tina Johns as a member of the Zoning Hearing Board of the Borough of Newburg, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania with the term of office to expire on January 1, 2021.

Section 2. In the event any provision, section, clause, or part of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses, or parts of this Resolution it being the intent of the Borough Council of the Borough that the remainder of the Resolution shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective as of January 2, 2018.


