**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF NEWBURG APPOINTING MELISSA NEGLEY AS A MEMBER OF BOROUGH COUNCIL TO FILL THE VACANCY IN OFFICE CREATED BY THE RESIGNATION OF SUSAN MOOSE.**

**WHEREAS,** Borough Council Member Susan Moose has submitted her letter of resignation from Borough Council which resignation was accepted by Council at its November 7, 2016 meeting; and

**WHEREAS,** Ms. Moose was elected as Council Member of the Borough in November 2013 for a four year term which would end on the first Monday in January 2018; and

**WHEREAS,** the resignation of Ms. Moose has created a vacancy on Borough Council which Borough Council has the authority to fill in accordance with Section 901 of the Borough Code; and

**WHEREAS,** Borough Council has deemed it in the best interest of the Borough to appoint Melissa Negley as a member of Borough Council for the remainder of the term of Ms. Moose; and

**WHEREAS,** Ms. Negley is a registered elector of the Borough and has been a continuous resident of the Borough for over one year; and

**WHEREAS,** the Borough Council deems Ms. Negley to be qualified to serve as a member of Borough Council.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Council for the Borough of Newburg as follows:


1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference hereto.
2. Melissa Negley is appointed to serve on Borough Council until the first Monday in January 2018 when the individual elected to Borough Council in the November 2017 election takes office.
3. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective immediately.


