RESOLUTION NO. 2018 - 01**

**A RESOLUTION FILLING A VACANCY OF TAX COLLECTOR CREATED WHEN
THE DULY ELECTED TAX COLLECTOR DECLINED THE POSITION**

WHEREAS, Richard Hockenberry, the last duly-elected tax collector of the Borough of Newburg, declined his re-election and resigned effective January 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Section 901 of the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 901, requires that "the borough council shall fill such vacancy within thirty days by appointing, by resolution, a registered elector of the borough . . . to hold such office, if the term thereof continues so long, until the first Monday in January after the first municipal election occurring more than sixty days after the vacancy occurs No person shall be appointed to fill a vacancy in an elected borough or ward office unless he or she has resided within the borough . . . continuously for at least one year immediately prior to his or her appointment."; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Newburg desires to appoint Jessica M. Wolfe to the position of tax collector for the Borough of Newburg; and

WHEREAS, Jessica M. Wolfe is willing to accept the position of tax collector for the Borough of Newburg.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved by the Borough Council of the Borough of Newburg, County of Cumberland and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania that:

1. **Jessica M. Wolfe**, having expressed an interest in collecting taxes for the Borough of Newburg, being a registered elector of the Borough of Newburg, Cumberland County Pennsylvania, and otherwise qualified under the Borough Code and Local Tax Collection Law, and having been nominated, seconded and approved unanimously by the borough council, at a duly advertised public meeting on January 15, 2018, is hereby appointed to fill the vacancy until such time as the position is filled as prescribed in The Borough Code.


